**Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 3500 characters, including spaces)**

I am Associate Professor (Contratado Doctor) at the Department of Foreign Language and Literatures at the Universitat de Lleida. I have been a member of research Group Dedal-Lit since 2002 and have participated in all the projects related to ageing studies, literature and narrative in which the group has been involved since then. Since 2022, I am IP of Dedal-Lit/CELCA (Centre de Literatures i Cultura en Anglès, UdL, Grup SGR Consolidat). I have been coordinador of the Primary Education Degree, Bilingual Modality, at the Faculty of Education, FEPTS (2013-2023) and vice-dean of Practicum at the Faculty of Education, FEPTS at UdL (2020-2023). I have been deputy treasurer of ENAS (European Network of Aging Studies) several years and I am currently Chair of ENAS Executive Board (2022-2024).

The most relevant research contributions in my cv can be summarised in the following ones:

- I have obtained two 'sexenios de investigación' from AGAUR with the minimum requirements achieved.
- I have published a number of articles in indexed journals (JCR, Arts and Humanities Citation Index, SCOPUS, ERIC, DICE, LATINDEX, among others).
- I have published articles in edited volumes, all of them related to cultural and literary gerontology, with a strong focus on gender. I have edited 3 collections of articles (listed below in 'Books' section). I have also been the general editor of issue 22 of *European Journal of English Studies* entitled "Approaches to old age: perspectives from the twenty-first century" (2018) with Dr. Sarah Falcus (U. of Huddersfield, UK).
- Since 2002, I have participated in five projects from Plan Nacional I+D (in one of the as co-IP); in one project within the EU 7<sup>th</sup> Framework Programme, in a project funded by the NOW the Netherlands Organisation for Scientific Research and in an K2Action Erasmus + Project.
