See info. - The City Explorer (leaving at the Albert Dock). See info. 	<p>Since you are at the Queens Dock and we'll visit the Albert Dock, you should not miss the Pier Head, one of the most impressive waterfront areas with three emblematic buildings: The Royal Liver Building, The Cunard Building and the Port of Liverpool Building, referred to as The Three Graces.</p>	<p>For drinks, beer, one of the agents at the tourist information office has suggested The Bierkeller at Liverpool One. Both he and the receptionist at your hotel have suggested Liverpool One as a place to go hunting for (cheap) food.</p>
